



# FAQ's



## **1. What types of activities will occur at the Explozone?**

The activities that will occur at the Explozone will focus on empowering teachers and their students to implement inquiry through hands-on experiences. Teachers wanting to participate, will be expected to co-plan and co-teach lessons with Curriculum department staff prior to coming to the Explozone. This centre essentially becomes an extension of the Curriculum department and as such, teachers involved in activities should expect to fully participate in the co-development and co-instruction of inquiry challenges and activities.

## **2. How can I obtain information about what is being offered at the Explozone for teachers? For students?**

## **3. How can teachers sign up to bring a class to the Explozone?**

Once you have signed up for a workshop series, engage in a conversation with the helping teacher responsible and indicate your desire to take your class to the Zone. Transportation can be arranged with your school. It would be important to discuss your arrangements and cost of transportation with your administrator if you require bussing to get to the zone.
